## SCHOLARSHIPS

The costs of attending medical school can easily top \$200,000 and take years to pay off, leaving you with an unhealthy financial diagnosis.

With a scholarship through the Air Force Health Professions Scholarship Program (HPSP), you can finish med school and achieve your goals without financial worries. We currently offer three- and four-year scholarships.

You'll be able to attend the accredited school of your choice and we'll cover the expenses. All tuition, books, supplies, equipment and lab fees are paid. Plus, you'll receive a generous monthly stipend for living expenses.

## YOUR PRACTICE

In your military medical practice you'll enjoy an outstanding network of colleagues, facilitating world-class healthcare around the globe.

Overhead expenses including malpractice insurance, staff and facility expenses, practice management costs and equipment are provided for you.

You'll focus on your passion — the practice of medicine.

## COMMITMENT

As a HPSP recipient, all we ask in return is your commitment to serve on active duty as an Air Force physician.

You'll have a year-for-year repayment, with a minimum obligation of three years for a three-year scholarship and four years for a four-year scholarship. Your tour of duty begins after you complete internship and residency training.

During each year of your scholarship, you'll serve 45 days on active duty for training while receiving the full pay and allowances of a second lieutenant.



## REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for a HPSP scholarship, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Be accepted to or enrolled in a medical school accredited by either the Association of American Medical Colleges (MD schools) or the American Osteopathic Association (DO schools) located within the continental United States, Hawaii, Alaska or Puerto Rico.
- Be selected and commissioned by age 39.
- Meet physical and moral requirements.

- Attend the accredited school of your choice
- Paid tuition, books, supplies, equipment and lab fees
- Monthly stipend for living expenses
- Graduate from medical school debt-free
